Tuition

Tuition is what you pay for the courses you take at university.

At \$5,482 per year for most programs at a full-time course load, the University of New Brunswick's tuition rates are extremely competitive. In fact, that's one of the lowest costs of tuition in the Maritimes.

Fees

Aside from tuition, there are also a few other fees, some mandatory and some optional. Most universities have fees for specific services that are not included in tuition costs.
